*Robert Scott Davis, Jr.*

is Director of the Genealogy Program of Wallace State Community College, Hanceville, Alabama. His duties include helping to build one of the South's most extensive genealogical collections; organizing field trips for his classes throughout the country; and teaching genealogy in one of the first colleges to offer genealogy as a college level course.

Bob holds a B.A. and M.Ed in History, M.A. from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. In 1995, he graduated from the Institute of Documentary Editing conducted by the National Historical Records Publication Commission of the National Archives.

Prior to joining Wallace State College as a professor of genealogy in 1991, Bob worked as a free lance historical researcher. His most important work has been trying to save Georgia's recorded heritage. He continues to be a significant resource for Southern research.

When not teaching, Bob writes articles and books, usually on Georgia records and history. In addition to almost thirty professional historical publications and over 600 publications total, he has also reviewed articles and books for the Georgia Historical Quarterly, South Carolina Historical Magazine, The American Genealogist, and Atlanta Historical Journal.
